

Info – Moving into Student Dorm

If you have been allocated a room in a student residence in Freising-Weihenstephan you have received respective information directly from Studentenwerk München.

When you're planning your travel arrangements, it is important that you keep in mind the **office hours of the Residence Halls in Weihenstephan** which you will find below. Please contact the caretaker of the respective hall of residence and identify yourself with your ID card or passport.

You will then receive the key for your room.

The office hours for Hall of Residence Weihenstephan I are:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between 11 a.m. and 12 h
Wednesday 2.30 p.m. – 3.30 p.m.

The office hours for Halls of Residence Weihenstephan II, III and IV are:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday between 1 p.m. – 2 p.m.
Wednesday 2.30 p.m. – 3.30 p.m.
Friday 8 a.m. – 9 a.m.

Attention: Due to a public holiday it is not possible to move in on October 3rd.

Please make sure you use the next opportunity to sign your tenancy agreement for your dorm room. For this purpose the Studentenwerk administrative office in Freising, Alte Akademie 1, 3rd Floor is open every first and third Wednesday in April and October between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.

All students who move to Freising for more than two months are requested to register within one week of their arrival at the Resident Registration Office (Bürgerbüro).

You will receive **per Email a so-called "Wohnungsgeberbestätigung"** which is a confirmation by Studentenwerk München that you have taken residence in a student dormitory in Weihenstephan. This document is necessary for your registration with the Bürgerbüro in Freising. The International Team offers to go there together in a group the day of the Weihenstephan Welcome.
